




VALERIE SINGLETON OBE ON SENIORS DRIVING

In parallel with the development of the C_Two, the Rimac Automobili business has continued to scale up, with Porsche increasing its ownership stake in the business to 15.5% and Hyundai Motor Group investing 80M EUR into the business.



oyota's mighty Land Cruiser gains even more power with the introduction of a new and efficient 2.8-litre engine, leading a series of performance and equipment updates for both the passenger and commercial versions of the SUV.

The new four-cylinder turbodiesel unit adds plenty of extra muscle to the world-famous Land Cruiser, delivering a maximum 201bhp/150kW at 3,000rpm and producing peak torque of 500Nm from 1,600rpm*. This marks an increase of 27bhp and 50Nm on the previous engine, gains that are reflected in a 2.8-second reduction in the 0-62mph time to less than 10 seconds.

This additional strength brings no penalty in terms of fuel economy or CO2 emissions. With the benefit of a stop-start system as standard, fuel consumption is in fact slightly improved.

The engine meets the UK's RDE2 (Real Driving Emissions) standard, so qualifies for a lower Vehicle Excise Duty charge - down by £325 in the first year compared to the current Land Cruiser.

The Land Cruiser line-up now offers two equipment grades, in line with customer preferences.

The Active grade is the new entry point to the range, available in three and five-door formats and with five or seven seats.

The specification gains wireless smartphone integration via Apple CarPlay and Android Auto as standard, together with an improved multimedia system. Operated via an eight-inch touchscreen, this benefits from faster software and command response and offers a customisable home screen so that owners can prioritise their most frequently accessed functions.

The Active grade's established features include 17-inch alloy wheels, cruise control air conditioning, smart entry and push-button start, roof rails and heated power door mirrors.

At the top of the range, the seven-seat Invincible also adopts the smartphone integration package and is newly available with an optional Black Pack. Customers who opt for black leather upholstery can also specify an all-black exterior, including the front grille, door mirror casings, rear light surrounds, side mouldings and rear garnish, plus clear lenses for the rear light clusters. The look is carried through to the cabin with black finish for the centre console and transmission tunnel. Black alloy wheels can also be specified, as an additional option.

The Invincible comes with a comprehensive, top-quality specification including systems to tackle the demands of different off-road conditions. Multi-Terrain Select, a rear differential lock, centre Torsen limited-slip differential and Crawl Control are all part of the technically advanced suite of control functions, plus Adaptive Variable Suspension with electronically modulated rear air suspension.

While being able to deal with challenging conditions, the Land Cruiser Invincible also offers a wealth of comfort and convenience features, including triple-zone climate control, power steering column and front seat adjustment, heated and ventilated front seats, heated second row seats, leather upholstery, multi-view monitor, 14-speaker JBL Synthesis premium audio system, LED headlights, 19-inch alloys, rear privacy glass and illuminated side steps.



Then from the end of 2021 the INEOS Grenadier is a full size multi seat alternative to the old school Defender.

Suzuki has introduced a new 2-seater light-commercial vehicle version of its small and lightweight off-roader, the Jimny. Since its launch in 2018, the model has attracted both private-users and professionals who seek for an authentic off-road performance.

To further meet the needs of professionals, the new Jimny light commercial vehicle model comes with a large luggage compartment with a flat floor and safety cargo partition.

Authentic off-road performance The light commercial vehicle model features the same authentic, uncompromising off-roading performance desired by professionals as the passenger vehicle model with key essentials – a ladder frame, the three angles, 3-link rigid axle suspension and ALLGRIP PRO, a part-time 4WD system with low range transfer gear.

Practical luggage space For enhanced utility, the light commercial vehicle model has a large 863-litre capacity, 33 litre more than the passenger vehicle model when rear sear seats are folded down, with a flat floor for better practicality and safety partition that protects cargoes moving into the cabin.

t is this time of year that most of all dread – Winter. Days are getting shorter and darker; nights are getting longer and typical unpredictable bad British weather awaits us. So let's see what we can do to get our cars ready for winter; spending some time now getting our cars ready could save us the heartache of a breakdown; being stranded on the side of the road on a freezing cold, rainy, or worst still – a snowy winter day.

Check Under Bonnet

Check your engine oil, brake fluid, power steering fluid, automatic transmission fluid, coolant and top up if needed, test the strength of your coolant antifreeze with a tester so you know that your engine and radiator will be protected when the temperature drops. Add 'winter screen wash' to your washer bottle as it has a much lower freezing point. Test your windscreen washer to ensure the jets are all working and spraying the windscreen evenly. Use an adjustment tool if any one of the jets is not reaching the glass sufficiently. Check the rear wash wipe works properly if you have one. If your car has headlamp washers, ensure they are working also. Check the condition of your air filter and replace if clogged. If you have a high-performance reusable air filter, check it and clean if necessary as we mentioned in last month's issue. Whist you are there look at the condition of your battery, if the terminals are corroded this is a good time to replace your battery. A fully charged battery should read 12.6 volts or above. When the engine is running, that number should be between 13.7 and 14.7 volts. Anything lower than 12.2 volts means you have a bad battery. You can check your battery voltage with a multi-meter. Also check the condition of the battery leads. Finally, check the condition of all the rubber hoses and belts, including the radiator hoses. If you have a modern diesel, make sure your 'AdBlue' tank is topped up.



Check Bulbs

Check all exterior bulbs are working including your fog lamps. If you have halogen bulbs, consider upgrading to brighter high-performance versions such as 'Osram Nightbreakers.' Check the condition of all light clusters.

Check Rubbers and Locks

Check condition of your wiper blades and all rubber door and boot seals. Spray silicone spray on rubber seals to prevent doors from freezing shut in cold temperatures. Clear all leaves and debris in boot, bonnet, and door shut lines. Ensure all water drainage channels are cleaned. Check the condition of your tyres. Check the pressures and tread depths are good. Consider switching to winter tyres. Don't forget to check your spare tyre. Look at the condition of your brake discs, pads and callipers. Check all your exterior locks are working. If your electronic key fob dies for whatever reason, then you will still be able to get into your car. Spray a small amount of WD40 into locks to ensure they are operating smoothly.

Wash and Wax

Give the bodywork a thorough rinse, pay attention to wheel arches. If your pressure washer has a under chassis adaptor jet, use it. Use snow foam and a good quality shampoo in a bucket of warm water and a microfiber mitt. Use a filter grate in your bucket to catch grit and keep it at the bottom of your bucket. Rinse the shampoo off and don't forget to clean your wheels with a suitable alloy wheel cleaner. Use a large microfiber drying towel to dry your vehicle. Use a wax with carnauba to protect the entire body. This will help repel rain and dirt and keep your car looking cleaner for longer during the winter months.

Glass Care and Interior

Use a quality glass cleaner and micro fibre cloth to clean all your exterior glass including your wing mirrors. From the inside, use another clean micro-fibre cloth to clean all glass including your rear-view mirror and sunroof glass. Vacuum all seats, carpets and mats including those in your boot. If you have a leather interior, clean the leather with a suitable leather cleaner then apply some leather cream. Install heavy duty rubber floor mats to protect your interior throughout winter.

Be Prenared

Kit your boot with an ice scraper and de-icer spray. Carrying a warning triangle and hi-vis jacket is also a good idea in the event of a breakdown. Make sure you have a bright torch plus extra batteries. A mobile phone charger, power bank, jump leads or battery booster is also a must. If the weather gets icy and snowy, keep a folding shovel in your boot. Make sure your First aid kit is up to date and pack it with any spare prescription medication. Also keep emergency food and water. Winter gloves, hat, coat, warm clothes, and a blanket could also be a lifesaver. Store hand sanitizer/ wet wipes and spare masks in your glove box in easy reach. Finally ensure your breakdown cover is up to date and the breakdown number is stored in your phone or make sure you have downloaded the emergency breakdown app.

Prepare Yourself

Doing a skid pan course is great fun. It will prepare you for what you need to do if ever you get into a skid and also teach you how to prevent getting into a skid by driving safely in snowy and icy conditions. On the skid pan, you will learn what understeer and oversteer feels like and how to correct the problem in a safe environment. If you wish to take your driving skills every further, consider doing the Advanced Driving Course as I did. It will take your enjoyment of driving to another level.







HE Proposed Motorway Speed Limit Reduction to 60mph Borders on Economic Vandalism

Highways England is proposing to reduce the motorway speed limit for all traffic, including zero tailpipe- (but in practice geographically displaced) emissions electric vehicles, to 60mph on some stretches. This is ostensibly to curb emissions. But this will not yield **any**meaningful NOx, PM2.5 or PM10 emissions reductions.

It has already been shown that 2017 car and taxi traffic (c.30.5m vehicles; covering 409.4 BnVkm) represented nearly 78% of UK's annual road mileage travelled, but only generated respectively 13.5% of national NOx and around 5% each of national PM2.5 & PM10s (see figure below left, and: https://www.abd.org.uk/political-establishments-persecution-of-car-drivers-istotally-unjustified/).

Meanwhile, 2017 public transport, heavy and light goods vehicle traffic (c.4.3m vehicles; covering 112.6 BnVkm) represented only 21.4% of annual road mileage, but respectively generated 18.5%, 6.85% & 6.28% of NOx, and PM2.5 and PM10s; each of these significantly more than the corresponding aggregate figures for car and taxi emissions; yet from numerically far fewer vehicles.

Most public transport, heavy and light goods vehicles are already electronically limited to less than 60mph by law, so their emissions will therefore be unaffected by any limit reduction.

What HE apparently totally fails to grasp [demonstrating a disappointing lack of: (a) comprehension of emissions science, and so (b) fitness-for-purpose] is that problem vehicle emissions peak at low speeds, not at elevated ones (see figure below right, and: http://content.tfl.gov.uk/london-exhaust-emissions-study-developing-a-test-programme.pdf, pp.18-35).

Substantially the highest emissions occur at speeds consistently below - and under acceleration to - 30mph.

Additionally, while motorways only represent 0.9% of the UK road network, they carry 21% of its road traffic.

Each 1 mph reduction in average traffic speed costs the UK economy in excess of £1Bn in lost productivity through extended journey times. A 10mph speed reduction for 78% (car/taxi) of motorway traffic is equivalent to £1BN x 0.78 (% cars/taxis) x 10(mph reduction) x 0.21% (% of annual mileage) = over £1.5Bn in annual lost productivity for no environmental gain. This at the very least amounts to economic mismanagement bordering on irresponsibility, just as the UK economy seeks to claw its way out of a deep, Covid-19 generated downturn.

HE should be facilitating enhanced traffic flow, supporting the introduction of a motorway speed limit at least 80mph, in line with 85th Percentile Principles. Instead it is proposing virtue-signalling, economically detrimental reductions.

Suzuki Swift Sport Hybrid

Rowing that this updated Suzuki Swift Sport is now a Hybrid, the presence of a full 6-speed manual gearbox and clutch takes you by surprise, albeit a pleasant one. In fact this is a mild hybrid 48-volt system with battery pack under the front seats and an additional motor. The electrickery employed serves to aid power to the electronics rather than sapping energy from the engine, plus aids in the smooth stop-start and adds a little extra torque at lower revs.

And you do feel a sprightly initial acceleration when first moving off, although the

figures compared to the previous version might seem disappointing at first (a second down at 8.1 for the 0-62mph sprint), but while it has less horsepower (127bhp vs 138bhp) it's up slightly on torque. Fuel economy improves by 3.0mpg to 50mpg and CO2 emissions fall from 135g/km to 127g/km. The price however rises to £22k, up nearly four grand.

If not quite in the pocket rocket league, it certainly is a fun and lively little car to peddle around town - chuckable, tenacious, engaging - yet boasting big car features on longer runs - adaptive cruise control and auto-dipping high beam. And of course it retains all the charms of the Swift that endear it so much to owners - the compact size but eminent practicality, reliability and ease of use. The only fly in the ointment is the price which pits against the Ford Fiesta ST, a fight it will always lose.

The Audi Q3 Sportback is a sleeker, sportier looking version of the Q3 family SUV. The coupe-like profile reveals bulging flanks that give it a more meatier and muscular stance. It looks bigger than a Q3 but it's actually narrower and five centimetres lower.

On this 45 TFSI Quattro test car there's a 2.0-litre turbo four-cylinder putting out about 230bhp and 258lb ft (350Nm) of torque, which provides 0-62mph acceleration in 6.5 seconds and up to 145mph. Official combined fuel consumption is about 32mpg with CO2 emissions up to 204g/km.

There are lesser petrol variants available and diesel versions too of course, but if you're after real muscle you want the 400bhp RS Q3 Sportback which starts at around £54k. This model lines up at just over £39k initially.

There's a generous amount of boot space, and in the rear decent knee-room, foot space and overall comfort is complemented by adequate headroom, though you might just find the top of your head occasionally brushing the roof lining.

With reassuring Quattro grip, even in frequently wet weather, the acceleration is more than enough for most needs. The ride is very well composed and keeps you cosseted, though things do get a little livelier in sports mode, and of course the brakes and grip are beyond reproach.

Style wins the argument and this would definitely be a more desirable choice over the regular Q3 with hardly much compromise.

Toyota RAV4 **Hybrid**

his is the fifth generation of a model line that was launched back in 1994 and arguably kicked off the trend and set the standard for affordable family SUVs. Known for its robustness, reliability, all-round ability and practicality; what it might have lacked, particularly in the last few generations, is visual distinctiveness and appeal. The latest version of the world's best-selling SUV, is a highly chiselled evolution making it the most stand-out RAV4 since the original 90s offering.

Like most of the Toyota range now in the UK, the RAV4 comes as a Hybrid with a 2.5-litre four-cylinder producing 215bhp and 163lb ft of torque. It's available as either a front-wheel drive or all-wheel drive with a 0-62mph acceleration time of 8.4 seconds for the two-wheel drive, and 8.1 seconds for the grippier 4x4. Official fuel con-



sumption figures range from 47-50mpg and CO2 emissions from 126 to 131g/km.

With prices ranging from £30,000 to £38,000, all models are extremely well equipped with Toyota Safety Sense as standard and that includes pedestrian and cyclist detection, lane departure alert, automatic high beam, road sign assist and adaptive cruise control.

As you'd expect the squared off design allows for maximising the luggage space, so capacity is 580 litres with all the seats in place, but drop the rear

bench and you can treat it like a van with nearly 1700 litres of space. In the rear there is ample space for six-foot plus occupants with knee and headroom to spare, particularly if you take advantage of the reclining seat backs.

It keeps up with traffic, grips decently, responds accurately, and can be hustled along if you need it to. With a focus on ease and convenience the drive is not taxing with light controls and good visibility. The ride, whilst being firm and transmitting some bump and thump into

the cabin, keeps the suspension travel in tight control. The car doesn't float, bounce or wallow, but it does glide.

The assurance of a five-year warranty is hardly necessary, from the moment you open the door and step in to the RAV4, you know that it stays true to its heritage of solidity and surety. This car will never let you down and endeavours to be extremely accommodating as well as an amiable companion, albeit now rather more impressively dressed than it's normally known for.

The Maserati MC20 supercar is a very important car for the luxury and performance Italian Marque, especially after its divorce from Ferrari. So how comes what should be yet another exciting new sportscar from a famed Italian company is so, well... meh?

They would argue it's subtle

and suave, taking styling cues from the mighty Maserati MC12 hypercar of 2004 (in fact the MC20 looks like a puppy dog version) and befits a stylish manufacturer that normally doesn't have to try too hard.

Well that's fine for the Quattroporte, Ghibli and Levante SUV, but not a

supercar that also happens to be such an important brand statement. Plus it only has a V6, a brand new one mind, but still.

I'm a Maserati fan, but they really needed to hit out of the park with this one. I fear the MC20 is simply not 'wow' enough.






